University of Manchester NHS membership

The University of Manchester Library provides a membership scheme open to all NHS employees within the North West. The NHS membership scheme is available free of charge to any member of the North West NHS workforce on production of their NHS identification card.

Services include:

- Access to main university library on Oxford Road
- Use of the online catalogue
- Loan of up to 4 items
- Walk-in access to e-journals and databases (restrictions apply)
- Use of photocopiers
- Reference and enquiry service
- Training and inductions

University of Liverpool NHS membership

This access is free to individual NHS staff members on production of their employment identity card. Individuals are expected to comply with the University Library's rules and regulations.

Services include:

- Access to the reading rooms and catalogues
- Loan of two items for two weeks
- Access to self-service photocopiers (users need to buy a photocopy card)
- An introduction to the library & its resources from a member of staff on request
- Access to e-resources if the University's licence allows such access (e.g. under "walk-in" access allowances)
